

## Speculative call-out for Forest School Assistants or Leaders in training

Are you a Forest School Assistant or Leader in training? Or one that's newly qualified?

I am in the process of preparing a site for Forest School sessions. I hope to be able to run sessions at that site, in the Abermagwr area, during the school week from end October 2025 onwards.

Would you be interested in volunteering during the school week in Winter 25 and into early 2026?

This is a *speculative call out* at this stage, as there's still a bit at the site to do and still a lot of variables in the mix. But, that also means, that I have a bit of flexibility to work with you on what day during the week such sessions could be run.

## I am looking for:

- Someone that understands the Forest school ethos and approach
   well this is key to the culture and how natur ni's forest school sessions are run.
- Someone that loves being outdoors in all weathers! I intend for sessions to run in wintertime (weather and health and safety permitting!) so you have to be okay with being outside in the rain and in the colder months.
- A Siaradwyr Cymraeg or someone who is learning Welsh: no matter
  what stage of your Welsh learning journey you are at.
   You could be a 'siaradwyr newydd' (new speaker), intermediate or
  advanced what matters to me is that you're willing to use the

- Welsh that you do have and build on it! I will support you in your learning/in the opportunity to use your Cymraeg.
- Someone who lives locally to the site (e.g. in the Abermagwr/
  Trawscoed/Llanilar/Llanafan/New Cross/New Row/Pontrhydygroes or
  wider Aberystwyth area) AND has access to their own transport\*?

## You can expect:

- A comprehensive induction.
- An opportunity to gain experience of assisting with forest school sessions.
- An opportunity to carry out your **practical assessment** (*if* you're still in training).
- A **safe space** where you can practice **speaking Welsh** (it's my 2<sup>nd</sup> language too we all had to start somewhere!)
- Expand your network of forest school contacts and landowners/sites.
- To feel part of a great little team, which aims to nurture diversity (in all its forms) and connection for all our mutual benefit.
- And most importantly, **to have FUN outdoors**, while inspiring others to do the same! ③
